What are we learning?

English: Will be looking at creating works of poetry, information reports and oral presentations linked with History. We will also continue to work on grammar, vocab, reading, editing and publishing.

Mathematics: This term we will be preparing for Napalm as well as consolidating general number knowledge, Bedmas, fractions, Chance and shape.

Science: We will be investigating 'Biological and Electronic Circuit Science'.

The Arts: This term student will look at acrylic painting, landscape painting/sketching and cartooning.

HASS: For History students will be working on an important project based around either Ancient Egypt Ancient Greece or Ancient Rome. In Civics student will be working on the Law and how the court system works in South Australia. We will also be visiting the courts later this term.

Health: We will have important daily fitness as well as building skills in structured play via dedicated P.E lessons.
