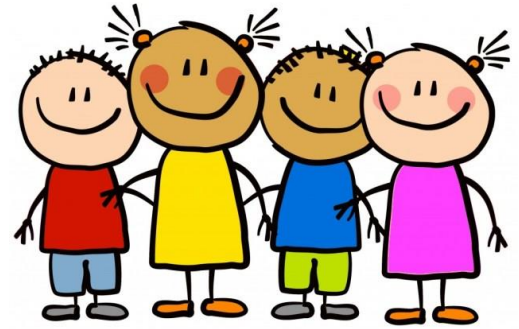


Room 1 Term 1 Overview



English

Reading and Viewing

- Read Write Inc.
- Daily reading using fiction and non-fiction readers, stories, big books, read-to-self and guided reading
- Reading strategies.
- Alphabet recognition – recall and production.
- Comprehension strategies – making connections.
- Red words to promote automatic recall of high frequency words.
- Concepts of print.

Listening and Speaking

- Read Write Inc.
- Sharing during morning Circle Time.
- Asking and answering questions, and making relevant comments
- Phonological awareness – identifying sounds, syllables and rhyme in words
- Expressing ideas, feelings and opinions in discussions

Writing

- Read Write Inc.
- Recounting events and experiences using main sounds and red words.
- Simple punctuation – capital letters and full stops.
- Handwriting – correct letter formation, writing on the lines and correct pencil grip.

Reception

Number and place value

- Counting in sequences to and from 20.
- Recognising, reading, writing and ordering numbers to 10.
- Subitising small collections of numbers.

Patterns and algebra

- Sorting and classifying familiar objects and explaining the basis for these classifications

Year One

Number and place value

- Develop confidence with number sequences to and from 100 by ones from any starting point.
- Recognise, model, read, write and order numbers to at least 100

History

- Who am I, where do I live and who came before me?
- How has family life and the place we live in changed over time?

Science

- Developing an understanding of how things move and exploring push and pull forces.
- Observing and gathering evidence about rolling objects and exploring the idea of fair testing.

Health

- Kimochis – characters and communication keys.
- Social and emotional learning.
- Child Protection Curriculum.

Physical Education with Mr Baker

- Team building and cooperation games.
- Loco-motor and manipulative skills.

The Arts with Ms Princi

- Dance styles from the 1970s.
- Drama games to develop confidence in using imagination and creativity.
- Performing facial expressions to show feelings and miming animal movements and traits.

Technology with Ms Princi

- Common digital systems and online safety.
- Simple algorithms using robots.

- Greeting and bowing.
- Recognising Hiragana and some Kanji numbers.
