English

Reading and viewing

- Read Write Inc.
- Daily reading using fiction and non-fiction readers, stories, big books, read-to-self and guided reading
- Reading strategies
- Alphabet recognition – recall and production

- Red words to promote automatic recall of high frequency words
- Concepts of print

Listening and speaking

- Read Write Inc.

- Asking and answering questions, and making relevant comments
- Phonological awareness – identifying sounds, syllables and rhyme in words
- Expressing ideas, feelings and opinions in discussions

Writing

- Read Write Inc.
- Writing from, with and independent.
- Simple punctuation – capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.
- Handwriting – correct letter formation, writing on the lines and correct pencil grip.

Number and place value

- Understanding the language and processes of counting by naming numbers in sequences.
- Developing confidence with number sequences from any starting point
- Connecting number names, numerals and quantities
- Recognising, modelling, reading, writing and ordering numbers
- Locating numbers on a number line
- Subitising small collections of objects
- Comparing, ordering and making correspondences between collections

Patterns and algebra

- Sorting and classifying familiar objects and explaining the basis for these classifications
- Investigating and describing number patterns formed by skip counting and patterns with objects
