Welcome back to term 3 Performing Arts. This term we will continue to embed the school values into our lessons, building student confidence, communication skills and group work skills

Performing Arts Lessons

Around the World (Rooms 2, 3, 4 and Pod 3)

We are beginning the term with a focus on the Olympics and creating scenarios around this theme. Later in the term we will start a journey travelling to different countries to learn different styles of music.

Exploring Sounds (Room 1)

We are continuing to explore the sounds that various instruments make and using instrument cards to help us compose music. We are enjoying creating characters and stories when using the dress ups.

Stage Directions and Scripts (Room 12)

We are looking at the basic elements of scriptwriting. We will also be using technology to learn about stage directions and to create our own stage.

Scriptwriting (Pod 2A)

We are going to look at how to use the conventions of drama to write a short script. Students will get to film their scenes and also compose their own music using their learning from last term around the elements of music.

Beat and rhythm (Pod 1 and 2B)

We will be learning about beat and rhythms and composing our own music. We will be learning how to play the various classroom instruments safely and correctly.

Senior Choir (Year 4-7)

The Senior Choir perform at the Entertainment Centre in week 8 this term. We will also have an excursion in week 6 to rehearse the music repertoire with other schools. We will continue to learn the music whilst also developing our singing and aural skills. Choir is held on Tuesdays at 2:15pm. A huge thank you to Rosie Fielder who has been a massive help during our choir lessons.

Dance Club

Dance Club is held in the Performing Arts room for students on Tuesdays during lunch time. Students learn and create simple choreography to music of their choice. This is open to all students and will continue throughout term 3 depending on interest. There will also be a cap on numbers each week.

Ingle Farm East's Got Talent

This will be held towards the end of the term and is open to all ages. Students will get to work on this during part of our Performing Arts lessons closer to the time.
